International Crime Prevention Specialist Training

A three-day **Crime Prevention Practitioner** seminar is planned for the later part of November. The Wed-Thu-Fri dates will be announced when they are finalized. The certification seminar is a joint project between the Las Vegas Chapter of ASIS International and the International Society of Crime Prevention Practitioners (ISCPP) <<http://www.iscpp.org>>.

The seminar consists of two comprehensive days of instruction followed by a final exam. The designation of **ICPS (*International Crime Prevention Specialist*)** will be conferred upon successful completion of the seminar and passing the final examination.

The total cost of \$275 includes ISCPP membership, the curriculum study manual, and the seminar. If you choose to begin studying in advance of the scheduled program, you can become a member and obtain the curriculum manual for **\$145.00** (go to the above ISCPP web-site). The balance of **\$130.00** would still be required for the seminar. **NOTE:** becoming a member and obtaining the curriculum in advance does not guarantee automatic reservation into the seminar. You **MUST** still pay the balance of \$130.00 as soon as you are able to commit to the soon-to-be-announced dates.

It is anticipated that registration capacity will be achieved soon after the dates are announced. Heavy interest is anticipated from out-of-state law enforcement agencies. Seating will be limited to the first 35 registrants that remit the full \$275.00 fee.
