### This Month's Speaker

D. Anthony Nichter, ARM, CHE, CPP, CPS, CDTI

D. Anthony Nichter is a veteran in the security tradecrafts with over 25 years of active service. He has conducted senior management-level seminars throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and Australia on behalf of private organizations and governmental tourism ministries. He has provided consultative and protective services to private companies, corporate executives, high-profile celebrities, and public agencies. Mr. Nichter is Board Certified in Security Management (CPP). He is also a Certified Hospitality Educator; a Certified Defensive Tactics Instructor; a Certified Handcuff Instructor; a Certified Protection Specialist and an Associate in Risk Management. Formerly an Adjunct Professor for the University of Nevada at Las Vegas for several semesters, Nichter is currently a faculty member at the Community

College of Southern Nevada. As a State of Nevada approved instructor for the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Nichter conducts the popular program Trial Testimony Preparation for Law Enforcement. He has authored over 25 articles that have been published in security newsletters and leading industry trade publications. In addition to developing his secular career, Mr. Nichter's personal studies include the integration of traditional martial art disciplines and Oriental Philosophy resulting in his ordination as a Zen Buddhist Priest of the Hsu Yun Order in March 2005.

### Legislative Alert

#### New "Email Law" takes effect October 1, 2008

As a result of Nevada legislative action taken a few years ago, a section of law is scheduled to take effect on October 1, 2008. It basically covers a business in Nevada sending personal information (such as a Social Security Number, Drivers License Number, etc. See below) via any "Electronic Transmission" that is not part of a secure system of that business. Sending personal information (Reports of Investigations, assignment sheets, etc.) via unsecure email would be a violation of Nevada law effective 1 October.

Below is the revised sections of Nevada Revised Statues

597.970, and related sections.

NRS 597.970 Restrictions on transfer of personal information through electronic transmission. [Effective October 1, 2008.]

1. A business in this State shall not transfer any personal information of a customer through an electronic transmission other than a facsimile to a person outside of the secure system of the business unless the business uses encryption to ensure the security of electronic transmission.

2. As used in this section:

(a) "Encryption" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 205.4742.

(b) "Personal information" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 603A.040.

NRS 205.4742 "Encryption" defined. "Encryption" means the use of any protective or disruptive measure, including, without limitation, cryptography, enciphering, encoding or a computer contaminant, to:

1. Prevent, impede, delay or disrupt access to any data, information, image, program, signal or sound;

2. Cause or make any data, information, image, program, signal or sound unintelligible or unusable; or

3. Prevent, impede, delay or disrupt the normal operation or use of any component, device, equipment, system or network.

NRS 603A.040 "Personal information" defined.

"Personal information" means a natural person's first name or first initial and last name in combination with any one or more of the following data elements, when the name and data elements are not encrypted:

1. Social security number.

2. Driver's license number or identification card number.

3. Account number, credit card number or debit card number, in combination with any required security code, access code or password that would permit access to the

person's financial account.

Ê The term does not include the last four digits of a social security number or publicly available information that is lawfully made available to the general public.
